Dear Colleagues: I am happy to announce that with the support of the University of Wisconsin-Madison and permission of the Hispanic Seminary of Medieval Studies the *Léxico hispanoamericano (LHA)*, edited by Ray Harris and John Nitti and published on CD-ROM in 2007, is now available on the web with interactive searches. You can find that project, as well as the *Corpus of Hispanic Chivalric Romances (CHCR)*, on the portal:

From the portal page you can select to enter the LHA or CHCR.

(Please note that the CHCR now has moved to this new server and while the CHCR's previous URL will temporarily forward users to it, you should take note of the new URL.)

It is strongly suggested that users read the help guides for the LHA before performing searches. I have tried to provide in those guides as much information as possible about the queries and how to use the site.

Both LHA and CHCR are continually being updated and improved. Searches are being developed for the CHCR, which we hope to have available by the end of the year. The LHA database can be expanded to add new material as scholars make it available to us.

All data on both sites are copyrighted by the Hispanic Seminary of Medieval Studies and programming and web page are property of the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin system. We are all very grateful to John O'Neill and the Hispanic Seminary of Medieval Studies for allowing us to make the LHA and CHCR available on the web and to the Hispanic Society of America for the images available on the CHCR.
